Welcome to our newsletter, which aims to keep you up-to-date with what is happening on our site.

### What we're building

BAM is proud to announce we will be delivering a new 2800m<sup>2</sup> specialist SEN teaching facility for SGS (South Gloucestershire & Stroud Colleges).

The project scheme comprises of the design and construction of a new all-through single storey school to occupy 80 mixed pupils with special education needs. The ages of pupils are between 4 and 19 years.

The single storey building will be 2,210m<sup>2</sup> GIFA located on the Patchway Community College playing fields.

The project will take approximately a year to build.

We will endeavour to coordinate and communicate any disruptive works with the local community & the college to ensure the project runs smoothly with minimal disruption to all.

### What's next?

Over the coming few weeks bam will begin mobilisation works on the site.

The first activity BAM will undertake is to secure the site preventing unauthorised access for the security of the member of the public, pupils, staff and the construction team. A breakdown of site activities are as follows.

- Secure & site setup w/c 15<sup>th</sup> October 18
- Cut & fill earthworks w/c 22<sup>nd</sup> October 18
- Temp services installation w/c 22<sup>nd</sup> October 18
- Drainage works through w/c 22<sup>nd</sup> October 18 playing fields
